
Table – 1 shows that 5.4% of the total population of India is slum population. Andhra has maximum ,12% of total state's population and Assam has minimum. 0.6%.


Of the tital slum population, Bihar has maximum, 17% of child population and Kerala has minimum, 10%.







<u>Sex Ratio</u> – General Sex Ratio of slum population is good for Kerala (1074), Pudducherry (1051), Mizoram(1022), Tamilnadu(1008), Meghalaya (998), Andhra Pradesh (996), Karnataka (994) and Tripura (993).

Ten states, namely Goa, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Maharashtra, Haryana, Gujarat, Delhi and Chandigarh, all have sex ratio below 900. Chandigarh has the lowest sex ratio, 784.


Child Sex ratio is good for Arunachal Pradesh (1020), Andaman & Nicobar (1015), Nagaland (996) and Sikkim (992). Seven states, namely, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab & Haryana all have Child sex Ratio below 900.







<u>SC/ST Slum Population</u> - Around 40% of slum population of Punjab is SC, Tamil Nadu has 32%, Chandigarh has 30% and Haryana has 30% SC slum population. Andaman & Nicobar, Arunachal Pradesh and Nagaland has no SC slum population.

About 94% of Mizoram slum population is ST, Nagaland has 78% and Meghalaya has 71% of ST slum population Chandigarh, Delhi, Punjab, Pudducherry and Haryana do not have any ST slum population.





<u>Literacy rate</u>: Literacy rate is highest, **85%** of slum population of Mizoram, followed by 84% in Kerala. Literacy rate is below 60% in Arunachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Jammu & Kashmir, Bihar and Chandigarh.



<u>Work Participation and Types of Work -</u> 36% of slum population of India are working , 86% of these are Main workers & 16% are marginal workers ( Table -2 ) . Sikkim and Tamil Nadu have maximum ( 41% ) working slum population and Bihar has lowest, 29%

In India, 2% of Main workers are cultivators, 6% are agriculture labourers and 5% are household industry workers ( Table 3 )

In India, 9% of Marginal workers are cultivators, 14% are agriculture labourers and 8% are household industry workers ( Table4 )
