As you aware, the KAYAKALP Scheme was launched by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), GOI as a national initiative on 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2015 to promote cleanliness and enhance the quality of public health facilities. The purpose of this initiative is to appreciate and recognise their efforts and create a healthy environment by giving awards to those urban health facilities that demonstrate high levels of cleanliness, hygiene and infection control.

- 2. During the first year (FY 2015-16), the scheme was applicable to District Hospitals & equivalent and during (FY 2016-17), the scheme was extended to SDHs/CHCs and PHCs. During FY 2017-18, the scheme was extended to the urban areas in respect of Urban Health facilities.
- 3. With reference to this Ministry's letter No. L.19017/6/2017-NUHM dated 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 to the States/UTs to facilitate extension of Kayakalp scheme to urban areas, it is requested to issue appropriate instructions for implementation of Kayakalp Scheme in urban health facilities under NUHM in a time bound manner.
