Subject: Online virtual training under NQAS & Kayakalp

Dear All,

As you are aware, in the current COVID pandemic situation most of the work, meetings, consultations and workshops are being conducted through online virtual mode, and trainings are also being imparted to the service providers across the country, in the similar mode.

Recently we have conducted the IA & SPT training under National Quality Assurance Standard (NQAS) program for the states of Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Bihar as they requested for virtual trainings. On the last day of the internal assessor training, post training evaluation also taken through the online mode.

As it is virtual training, time management is an important prerequisite for conducting training effectively & timely manner. In view of this, training can be conducted on two or three days depending upon the type of training. The duration of the training would be four to five hours per day.
