The Motto of the State of Andhra Pradesh is to provide Comprehensive and Quality Health services at all public health facilities to every citizen coming to the facilities and also to deliver Quality **outreach** services .

In order to achieve that objective, the AP Govt has taken up implementing NQAS recommended by GOI in all DH/AH/CHC/MCH/PHC/UPHC and HWCs and LaQshya standards in all facilities providing MCH services. The government has decided to implement NABH Standards in all Teaching Hospitals.



State of Andhra Pradesh is committed to provide Quality Health care services to its citizen. In order to provide Quality Health care services, State is decided to ensure the following in Two Years.

1. Up-gradation of all Sub Centres, Primary Health Centres, Community Health Centres, Sub-Division Hospitals and District Hospitals as per IPHS Standards.
2. All the Services provided at SC, PHC, CHC, SDH and DH shall be as per NQAS Standards.
3. Every Labour Room and Maternity ward (irrespective of Number deliveries conducted as per mortality) shall be as per LaQshya Standards.
4. All the Teaching Hospitals shall provide the services as per NABH Standards.
5. All the Private Hospitals (which are empanelled in State Insurance authority) shall implement NABH Standards.



In order to ensure the above, following actions initiated / implemented :-

- i. Sanctioned 6868 of New posts of Medical Paramedical and Nursing for PHC to DH.
- ii. All the PHCs upgraded as 24 x 7.
- iii. Approved for fill up all the vacant posts and New posts from SC to TH
- iv. Implementation of NQAS : PHCs, CHCs, SDH and DH shall implement NQAS Standards.
- v. All the Teaching Hospitals shall implement NABH Standards.
- vi. Sanctioned New Buildings and renovation of Buildings taken up in a big way with Rs.1950 Cr under Nadu Nedu (Then and now) Programme.



Implementation of NQAS in the State :-

- 1) State as part of its health policy, decided to ensure that all the Health facilities from DH to SC shall be NQAS compliment.
- 2) State has designed the following strategies for implement the NQAS.
 - 1) Vertical implementation strategy
 - 2) Horizontal implementation strategy
 - 3) Quality improvement as regular Job Chart
 - 4) Involvement of top management at state and District level

Vertical implementation strategy :-

1. All the State Programme Officer, Joint Directors, Additional Directors were Trained extensively on NQAS. They have prepared action plan to ensure Every check / provision / Standards of the check list is implemented in all facilities in their area.
2. These action plans are implemented in all facilities from DH to SC.
3. SPO / JD/ Addl Directors shall ensure that closure of the identified Gaps in Baseline assessment of facility.
4. Certain procurements made centrally to save time and funds.



Horizontal implementation strategy : -

1. All the facilities shall implement the Programmes irrespective of whether certified or not certified.
2. Quality Assurance Committees constituted in every facility and intensive training imparted to them in NQAS.
3. Every employee of facility was trained in NQAS and his / her role in NQAS implementation.



Quality improvement as regular Job Chart : -

1. Principal Secretary reviews the programme of Quality in public Health facilities on monthly basis.
2. MD, NHM review programme on weekly basis.
3. All District Level Joint Collectors (IAS Officer) made in charge of Quality Assurance Programme.

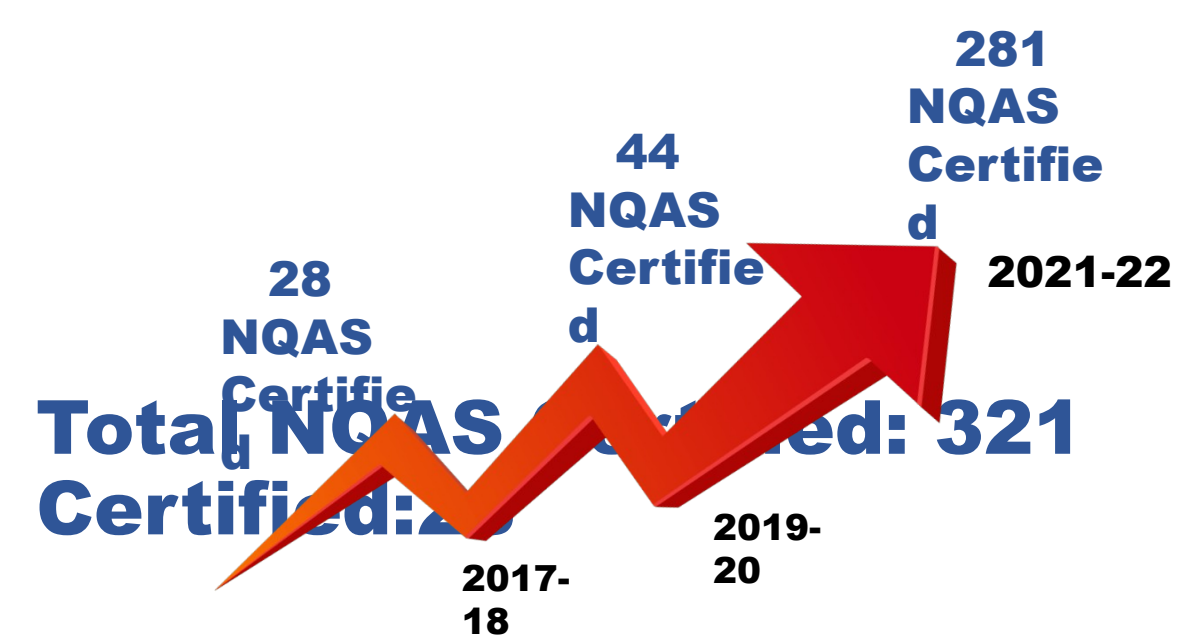
