## Dear Colleague,

India has made commendable progress in reducing child mortality. However, there is a need to undertake concerted efforts for enhancing quality of care in paediatric services delivered in public health facilities for having further improvement in outcomes

Recently, MusQan initiative has been launched to address the facility level issues regarding quality of care. The State Program Officers have been oriented on this initiative on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2021. You are requested to issue necessary instructions for development of an action plan for implementation of MusQan initiative. Following activities may be included in the MusQan implementation plan:-

- 1. Identification and listing of health facilities in the state/UTs having SNCU/NBSU/Paediatric ward/NRC where MusQan initiative could be implemented in the year 2022-23 & 23-24.
- 2. Baseline assessment of departments, where New born and paediatric services are being delivered. The assessment team should have at least one Paediatrician/clinician having formal NQAS Internal Assessor Training. Trained NQAS External Assessors may function as a resource for training of NQAS internal assessors. List of NQAS Internal Assessors and External Assessors is attached as Annexure.
- 3. Submission of baseline NQAS score and MusQan indicators through GUNAK app by  $28^{th}$  February 2022.
- 4. Identification of experienced resource persons to render mentoring support and formation of District and State level mentoring teams for conduct of Rapid Improvement Cycles followed by closure of critical gaps.
- 5. State level ToT of identified experts.
- 6. State PIPs (22-24) to reflect resources required for MusQan related activities.

The health facilities which are already NQAS or LaQshya certified District Hospitals and other FRUs may be taken on priority for implementation of the MusQan initiative.
