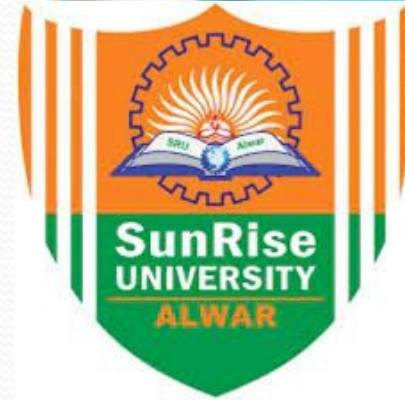

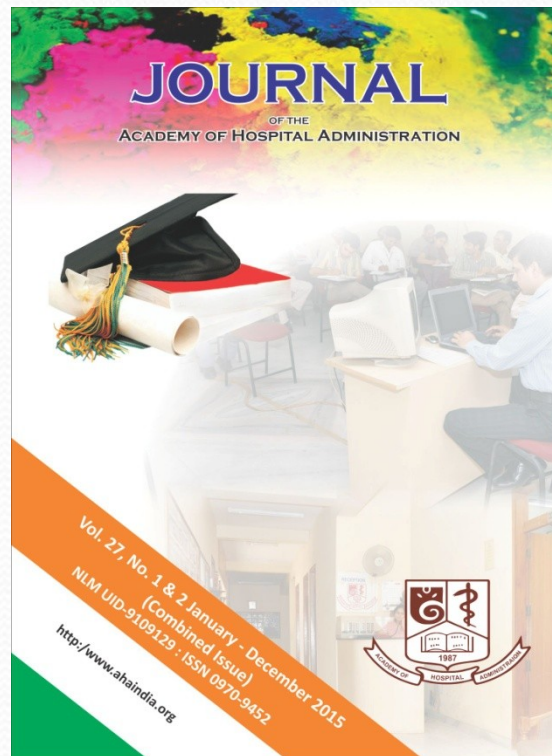

Implementation Strategy for last mile capacity building



- Basis the request from states activate local chapters to facilitate
- Get the pre-designed program (training topics, material etc.) customized for the states and duly validated by state/s
- Roll out the approved program strategically at the state HQ, district HQ and block level; separate for different categories of staff
- Hand hold hospitals for process implementation with a mix of online and offline training
- Deploy resources on a cluster approach
- Monitor progress on monthly basis
- Develop online tool for regular reporting
