1.	Conceptualize an overall quality accreditation framework to improve the quality of care in 167 facilities
2.	Rapid assessment & training need assessment of facilities using existing NQAS, LaQshya, MusQan & AB PMJAY standards
3.	Identify gaps in availability, knowledge and practice at health care facilities for further strengthening
4.	Capacity building & trainings of hospital staff on quality, infection prevention etc. in cascade model
5.	Provide recommendations to improve the quality parameter for the hospital include infrastructural, clinical services, supports services, patient care & health outcomes
6.	Provide support in conducting district, state and national assessment for quality certification under NQAS, LaQshya, MusQan & AB PMJAY

Facility Assessment Approach

Assessment for **167 facilities** include base hospitals, district hospitals, sub district hospitals CHCs & PHCs

Comprehensive one-stop shop for assessing each facility's service availability and readiness

Data received from the assessment will be essential in improving the quality of care & services
