Genesis Assessment Tool

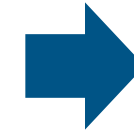


Facility Specific Improvement Plan

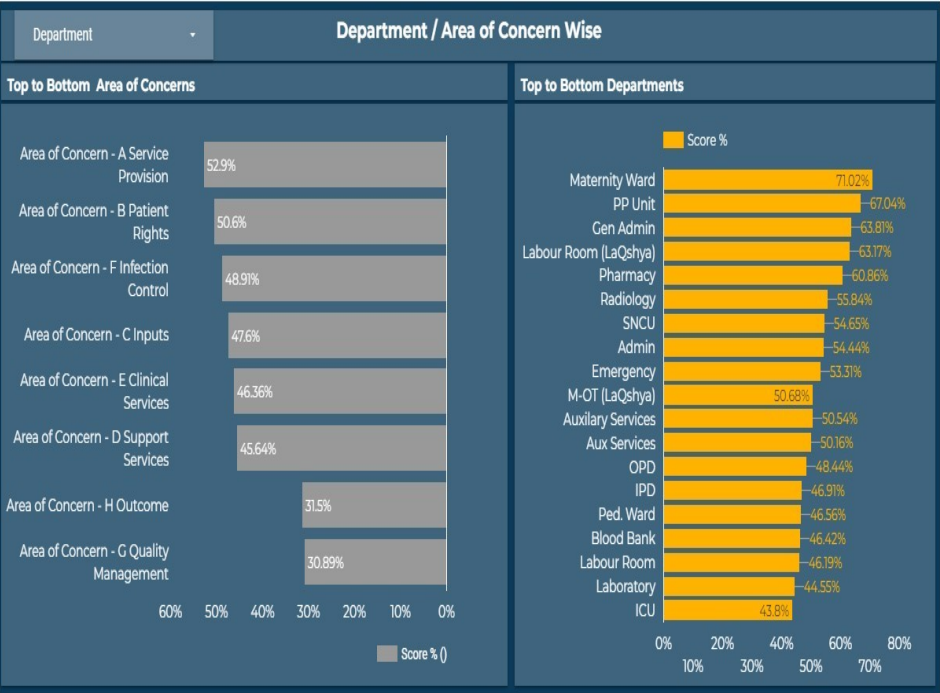

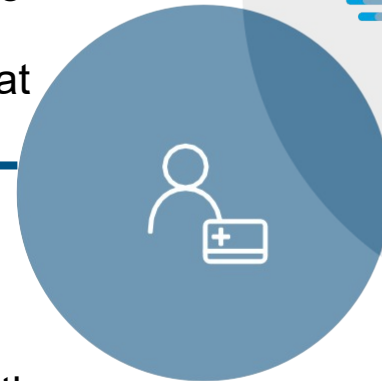
