Subject: Online Lecture Series on Standard Treatment Guidelines

Dear Collegues,

Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) is one of the major causes of morbidity and mortality in worldwide. COPD is caused by exposure to inhaled noxious particles, notably tobacco smoke and pollutants. However, the broad range of factors that increase the risk of development and progression of COPD throughout the life course are increasingly being recognised. Innovations in omics and imaging techniques have provided greater insight into disease pathobiology, which might result in advances in COPD prevention, diagnosis, and treatment. Although, COVID-19 has undeniably affected individuals with COPD, who are not only at higher risk for severe disease manifestations than healthy individuals but also negatively affected by interruptions in health-care delivery and social isolation.

The Sustainable Development Goals aim to reduce by one third premature mortality from NCDs through prevention and treatment and promote mental health and well-being by 2030. The global burden of disease study for India reported the prevalence of COPD increased from 3.3% (28.1 million cases) in 1990 to 4.4% (55.3 million cases) in 2017. It was noted that the prevalence of COPD among individuals between 30 years and above increased from 1.6%–28.3% among the population.

Focusing on diagnosis, treatment and complications of COPD, the next session of virtual STG Lecture series-"Diagnosing & treating COPD challenges" will be scheduled on 17^{th} Dec' 2022. The session will taken by Dr K K Chopra, Director-New Delhi TB Centre.
