Subject: Online Lecture Series on Standard Treatment Guidelines

Dear *All,*

Trauma is “an emotional response to a terrible event like an accident, rape, or natural disaster,” where the physical trauma is defined as wounds produced by sudden physical injury, violence, or accidents. Road traffic accidents involving motor vehicles, motorbikes and pedestrians are the most common trauma requiring hospital admission into intensive care in the hospital.

WHO reported nearly 1.3 million death occurs due to Road traffic accidents and 50 million were injured every year in the world. Therefore, UN Sustainable goal 3 says ‘to achieve 50% reduction in road traffic injuries by 2030.’

In India, every year approximately 1.5 lakh people dies due to road traffic accidents, which means average 47 accidents and 18 deaths every hour. Many deaths are due to non-effective management of trauma cases immediately after admission and sometimes due to delay in transportation of patient to hospital.

By considering the importance of essential management of trauma cases at early stage and to achieve sustainable development goal, the next session – “**Trauma management Essentials: Do’s and Don’ts for effective care**” has been scheduled on 19th August 2023. **Dr Amita Gupta**, Professor & Head, Department of Surgery, AIIMS Trauma Centre, New Delhi will be the speaker of this session.

Along with this the technical session on “**Prescribing Safety Check: Navigating Drug Interactions and Avoiding Errors**” will be taken by **Dr Sangeeta Sharma**, Professor-IHBAS and President, DSPRUD.
