



#### INTERNAL ASSESSORS CUM SERVICE PROVIDERS TRAINING REPORT RAJASTHAN th th

8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> April 2024

## <u>Background</u>

A Three-day training "Internal Assessors cum Service Providers Training" was conducted in the state of Rajasthan by the National Health System Resource Centre in collaboration with the State Institute of Health and family welfare from 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

The objective of the training was to train the nominated officials of the State for the implementation of the National Quality Assurance Program, by mentoring the facility quality teams as per the action plan defined by the State. This training will aid participants with the tools, techniques, and support to health professionals to enable them to implement NQAS at healthcare facilities and thereby, take ownership of improving, sustaining, and creating a culture of the quality of care.

The State had nominated 55 participants for the training including Community Health Officers, from different Districts. The training constituted eighteen (16) topics with seven (07) exercises for hands-on experience in the application of certain quality tools.

The training was initiated with an inaugural keynote Dr Mahesh Sachdeva - Quality Assurance, Rajasthan discussed about the importance of Quality in Healthcare service delivery and the current status of the NQAS certifications in the State.

A post-training evaluation was also taken during the training, post-training evaluation was an openbook exam with 42 multiple-choice questions, related to quality improvement and the NQAS framework. Out of a total of 55 participants, 54 participants (98%) cleared the post-evaluation exam and now will be empanelled as an internal assessor under the existing pool of NQAS.

QA training programmes have an inbuilt training evaluation system, where a feedback form is provided to each participant. Feedback of the participants is analyzed on a 5-point Likert scale. The overall rating of the training as per the analysis of the feedback from the participants was 4.53 on a 5-point Likert scale.

Key Concepts and Principles of Quality, Overview of National Quality Assurance Standards	Swain	This session covered key concepts of Quality, the importa of Quality in healthcare, the Evolution of the National Qua Assurance Standards & their implementation framew various initiatives/schemes under the National Qua Assurance Program, rationale and context, etc.
Measurement system and Assessment Protocol and Checklist	Dr. Chinmayee Swain	This session covered the concepts of the Measurement sys under the National Quality Assurance standards. It descri the 8 Areas of Concern, Standards, Measurable Eleme Checkpoints, and Means of Verifications defined under NQAS. It also included the scoring system with a discussio different assessment methods and departmental checklist various levels of healthcare facilities.
Quality standards under NQAS- AOC A (Service Provision) & B (Patient Rights)	Dr. Chinmayee Swain	The session included an elaborative discussion about the two areas of concern i.e., Service Provision (A) and Pat Rights (B). It included a brief of the availability of services public health facility as per the scope of the hospital and importance of patient rights while availing the services hospital.
Quality standard under NQAS-AOC C (Inputs) & D (Support Services)	Dr. Chinmayee Swain	It included the inputs required by a facility for healther service delivery, covering the availability of adequinfrastructure, human resources, training, competencies, the availability of essential drugs and consumables. Un support services, a detailed discussion of its 12 standards undertaken which included the maintenance of equipm calibration, inventory management, dietary services, laur services, security services, community participation, finar management, contract management, legal & statu requirements, etc.
Quality standard under NQAS-AOC E (Clinical Services)	Dr. Chinmayee Swain	The session briefed participants regarding the general specific clinical service standards from E1 to E24. It cover the process from registration to discharge and end of life unt these standards, including the referral service. The session discussed the importance of quality of clinical services with focus on standards of special Clinical services such as numcare, drug administration, patient record maintenance, discharge process, etc.

Quality standard under NQAS-AOC F (Infection Control) Quality standard under NQAS-AOC G (Quality Management)	Dr. Chinmayee Swain Dr. Chinmayee Swain	The session covered a detailed discussion about infection control practices and the standard precautions to be taken into consideration. It included the discussion on the latest biomedical rules and the amendments with a focus on the implementation and assessment of infection control practices at public healthcare facilities. Additionally, the key concepts of an Infection Control Audit were briefed to the participants. The session covered the steps in the formation of a quality team in the facility and, the importance of recording minutes of meetings (MOM) after every meeting. It also explained implementing IQAS and EQAS at the facility, conducting quarterly internal assessments of all the departments, identifying gaps, and mitigation plans to close them. The formation of the Quality policy and the objectives of the facility were also discussed.
Quality standard under NQAS-AOC -H (Outcome)	Dr. Kiran Arora	The session included a discussion on the KPIs and Outcome indicators under the NQAS along with their calculation, reporting, and analysis at the facility, district & state levels.
PDCA / 5S with Exercise	Dr. Siddhi Dhond	This session taught the Plan, Do, Check, Act cycle for improvement and sustenance of progress achieved after the incorporation of intervention/change in the process for achievement of set objectives. The concept was well-illustrated with examples. It also illustrated that by implementing 5S, we can minimize waste, streamline procedures, and ensure a sustainable foundation for quality in the facility, with an exercise.
Process Mapping with Exercise	Dr. Sachdeva	This session helped participants gain a clear understanding of how a process functions, identify areas for improvement, and ensure consistent quality outputs, with an exercise by the participants.
Prescription Audit with exercise	Dr. Sachdeva	It covered how to conduct a prescription audit at the facility with the help of an example. The exercise was done by the participants on prescription audit.
Internal Assessment and Gap Analysis with Exercise	Ms. Priti	This session covered the process for internal assessment and then identifying the gaps with an exercise by the participants.
RiskManagementandPrioritizationwith Exercise	Dr. Chinmayee Swain	This session covered the approach to identifying potential risks that could hinder the quality objectives and assess the likelihood and impact of each risk, allowing focus on the most critical ones. The exercise was done by the participants.
Clinical Governance	Dr. Chinmayee Swain	This session covered Clinical Governance in the facility and conducting different audits was re-explained briefly.
