NHSRC on behalf of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has been observing World Patient Safety Day every year since 2020 to increase public awareness and engagement. This is in accordance with World Health Assembly resolution WHA 72.6 on 19th May 2019 urging the member countries to keep patient safety as a key strategic priority.

The theme for World Patient Safety Day 2024 is "Improving diagnosis for patient safety". The themes call for concerted efforts to significantly reduce diagnostic errors through a variety of interventions rooted in systems thinking, human factors and actively engaging patients, their families, health workers and healthcare leaders. The key slogan for the 2024 campaign is "Get it right, make it safe"
