For meeting the above-mentioned targets, we have conducted a trend analysis of the NQAS certification in your State, findings are given below:

- The overall percentage of NQAS in the state against HDI 2022-23is 12% only.
- The progress of District Hospital is 16%, Sub-District Hospital is nil, Community Health Centre is 2%, Primary Health Centre 5%, Urban Primary Health Centre is 30% and AAM-SC is 13%.
- It has also been observed that the numbers of state certified UPHC have declined in the last quarter.

I would like to urge the state of Odisha to take up the NQAS certification for the health facilities in mission mode. All health facilities must undergo State level NQAS certification initially and 50% of State level certified facilities need to be converted into Nationally NQAS certified within six months of attaining the State certification.
