The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has issued list of Essential Medicines and Essential Diagnostics to be made available at public healthcare facilities. The number of minimum essential medicines prescribed for Sub Health Centre - Ayushman Arogya Mandir (SHC AAM) is 106, for Primary Health Centre Ayushman Arogya Mandir (PHC AAM) - 172, for Community Health Centre (CHC) - 300, for Sub-Divisional Hospitals (SDH) - 318, and for District Hospital (DH) - 381. Similarly, the number of diagnostics in the Essential Diagnostics List for each facility i.e. SHC is 14, PHC - 63, CHC - 97, SDH - 111, and for DH - 134.

Support is also available for setting up a robust system of procurement, Quality Assurance, supply chain management and warehousing, prescription audit, grievance redressal, dissemination of standard treatment guidelines, and the establishment of an IT-enabled Drugs & Vaccine Distribution Management System (DVDMS) portal, for monitoring the real status of procurement and availability.

However, the effective execution of this initiative depends largely on the States/Union Territories. I urge your kind intervention for taking following measures:

- Ensuring timely procurement and availability of essential drugs and diagnostics at all public health facilities.
- Establishing strong supply chain mechanisms to guarantee timely delivery, reduce stock-outs and wastage, and maintain proper storage conditions.
- Implementing robust monitoring mechanisms and feedback processes involving health professionals, public representatives, and citizens.
- Launching comprehensive public awareness campaigns through media, community outreach and elected public representatives to educate citizens about free services and promote their utilization.
