Ensure the availability of racks/ Almirahs/ shelf etc for storing medicines, Consumables & equipment etc. Covered Waiting Area with proper sitting space

Adequate space for conducting Lab investigations

Adequate space for conducting Yoga sessions

Demarcated area for immunization

ME C1.1 - Facility has adequate infrastructure, space and amenities as per patient or workload

Ensure availability for power back up and use of energy efficient bulbs

CUG numbers/ Landline and internet connectivity

Labour table with mattress, Newborn care corner (For Type B SCs)

Ensure intact boundary wall with adequate height

Ensure that toilets are functional with running water facility and are disable friendly

Ensure Potable drinking water supply for patients, visitor & staff

Water Storage facility – Minimum 3 days and periodic chlorination & Quality testing of water is done

ME C1.2 - The facility ensures physical safety including electrical and fire safety of infrastructure

Ensure that fixtures & furniture like Almirah/ Cabinets, hanging objects are properly fastened & secured

Ensure Seismic safety

Ensure that there is loosely hanging wires/temporary connections

Fire Safety – Ensure availability of ABC type Fire Extinguisher with regular

PASS- Pull the pin, A- Aim at base of fire, S- Squeeze the lever, S -Sweep side to side



ME C2.1 - The facility ensures availability of Community Health officer

Community Health Officer (CHO)

- Mentoring ASHAs and MPWs on all expanded package of services
- Ensure 100% population enumeration
- Provide facility based services Carry out basic clinical and public management
- facilitate referrals at a higher-level facility/teleconsultation with a specialist as required
- Lead the team of MPWs and ASHAs
- Report to PHC Medical Officer

ME C2.2 - The facility have adequate frontline health workers and support staff as requirement

ASHA

- Awareness, Identification and mobilization
- Population enumeration in the village
- Ensuring Screening
- follow up for compliance to treatment through regular home visits
- Facilitate conducing meetings of patient support groups.

ANM/MPW

- Support Awareness, Identification and mobilization
- Ensure and Support in Population enumeration in the village by ASHAs
- Organize and conduct screening
- Counselling
- Support Home based care
- Organize patient support groups
- Support treatment adherence

ME C2.3 – The facility has established procedure for duty roster for facility and community staff

Ensure that duty roster is prepared prepared, updated & followed for all cadres

Staff adhere to their respective dress code and wear their ID card

Ensure that field visit plans are prepared, updated & followed by primary healthcare team

Standard C3 – Facility has a defined and established procedure for effective utilization, evaluation and augmentation of competence and performance of staff





ME C3.1 – Competence assessment and performance evaluation of all staff is done on predefined criteria

Ensure that the competence of staff based on job description is assessed objective checklist (At least by PHC- MO once in a year)

Records for annual performance appraisal has to be maintained

Training need analysis to be done at defined intervals & adequate skill are provided

ME C3.2 – The staff is provided training as per defined core competencies and training plan

Records to be maintained for:

- (1) 6 months certificate program in Community health,
- (2) 3 days IT training including Tele medicines
- (3) 5-7 days supplementary training on new health programs, new skills (if applicable)
- (4) refresher every year (if applicable)
- (5) Basic physiotherapy (for elderly & palliative care)
- (6) Training on Eat right tool kit

Records to be maintained for:

MPW-(F):

- (1)4-5 days training in IUCD insertion, NSSK, HBNC Supervision, Management of Childhood illness,
- (2) 21 days of SBA training (SC Type B)

MPW (All):



- & basic nursing care training (esp. for elderly & palliative care)

ANM:

- (1) 8 days induction training, 20 days training of module 6& 7, 5 days NCD module.
- (2) Supplementary & refresher training for 15 days/year. (if applicable)
- (3) ASHA facilitatory is trained for Basic physiotherapy (for elderly & palliative care package),
- (4) Training on Eat right toolkit


