Improper antibiotic use in children poses significant immediate and long-term health risks, primarily driven by the development of antibiotic resistance and the disruption of the developing gut microbiome. Short-term risks and immediate adverse effects are antibiotic resistance, diarrhoea, nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain, allergic reactions, anaphylaxis etc.

Improper use of antibiotics or incorrect dosing can lead to treatment failure, need for more complex medical interventions and anti-microbial resistance. Practices such as self-medication by parents, using leftover antibiotics, or not completing the full course of treatment contribute to these risks.

To create awareness of rational use of antibiotics, the 36th webinar session will include a talk on **"Anti-microbial Stewardship"** by Dr Sangeeta Sharma, Professor & Head Neuropsychopharmacology, IHBAS, New Delhi and **"Identification of danger signs & symptoms of communicable diseases"** by Dr Romit Saxena, Professor-Paediatrics, Lok Nayak Hospital, New Delhi respectively.

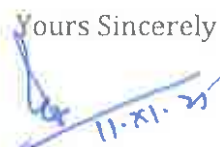
