

Certification assessment of Primary Health Care facilities (HWC-SC/HWC-PHC/PHC/U-PHC) in a district may be planned at the district level through a robust system of peer assessment. Such team will have at least one experienced NQAS Internal Assessor from another district.





Assessment is conducted and virtual monitoring is done from national level.

9. Last 3-months data from drug stock register for drugs availability as per state's notified Essential Medicine List, signed by CHO or equivalent\*

# Certification Outcome



## Fully Certified

- Overall score- 70% or above
- Met all Criteria

Facility can apply for Recertification after completion of validity through Virtual Mode.

## Conditionally Certified

- Overall score- 60% to 69%
- Met five/four out of six mandatory criteria

## Deferred


- Overall score-less than 60%

# Physical Verification of Virtually Certified facilities

Random Selection of certified AAM-SHC facilities of each State/UTs for physical verification assessment.

Scheduling of the assessment by team of 1 External Assessor & 1 Ayushman Assessor within 30 days .

Intimation letter or invitation email sent to the State and the deputed assessor at least 10 days before the scheduled assessment.

Name of the facility is communicated on the day of the scheduled assessment with the State and Assessors.

Physical verification assessment is conducted on scheduled date.

Deputed Assessors submit the report in prescribed format within 3 days of completion of assessment, result communicated to state

Respected Sir /Madam,

As you are aware, under the ambit of National Quality Assurance Standards (NQAS) there is provision of State and National level Quality Certifications. It is reiterated that all facilities are expected to achieve National Certification of all departments of health facility.

State Certification is an intermediary step for achieving National certification and every health facility should be nudged to go for the national certification within six months of getting the State NQAS certification. While the requirement against each criteria for the state certification is 5% lower as compared to the score against the criteria for the national certification, the assessment team for state level certification needs to observe the same assessment protocol as that of national-level assessment. States may also like to go for national assessment of the facilities that have scored above the national criteria, within a shorter time period.

As deferment of national certification for state certified facilities not only demotivates the staff but also results in greater resource diversion, it is also expected that States will ensure that there is no laxity in State assessments.

You may like to institutionalize a system of regular monitoring of the NQAS Certification in your State and UT, so that all the public health facilities for state level certification achieve the national level certification by December 2026 as communicated in Health Secretary's D.O. Letter No.Z-18015/13/2023-NHM dated 03<sup>rd</sup> February 2024.

Subject: Expansion of Quality Certification of Ayushman Arogya Mandir - Sub Health Centres to All 12 Service Packages under NQAS

Dear Mission Director,

National Quality Assurance Standards (NQAS) for Ayushman Arogya Mandir – Sub Health Centres (AAM-SHCs) were introduced in December 2020. According to the National Quality Assurance Standards Assessor's Guidebook, facilities seeking state and national certification were previously required to apply for at least seven (7) mandatory service packages. Since its inception, 90% of AAM-SHCs across 28 States/UTs have been certified under these seven mandatory service packages.

2. In an effort to enhance the availability and scope of services at AAM-SHCs, it has been decided that, effective April 2025, applications for national assessments will be accepted for all twelve (12) service packages. These assessments will be conducted through both physical and virtual modes.
3. You are requested to direct the State Quality Assurance Units to ensure that applications for NQAS certification encompass all twelve (12) service packages available at AAM-SHCs.

Dear Mission Director,

Since the launch of the Virtual Assessment for Ayushman Arogya Mandir – Sub Health Centres (AAM-SHCs) on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2024, a significant number of applications have been received from various states for virtual certification.

As per the approved protocol for the virtual certification, 10% of the facilities achieving NQAS certification in virtual mode will also undergo onsite assessment for physical verification. The boarding, lodging, honorarium, and other expenses for physical verification will be borne by the state as per the norms.

The following decisions have been taken to enhance the credibility of virtual assessments –

1. It is reiterated that the Facilities must meet the CQSC-approved certification criteria to be eligible for the weightage calculation approach for the virtual certification.
2. States to ensure proper network connectivity during the virtual assessment. (In case, the virtual assessment is cancelled due to poor network connectivity, or any other reason, such AAM-SHCs will undergo for assessment in physical mode.)
3. Facilities achieving Quality Certification/Quality Certification with conditionality may apply for re-certification in virtual mode.
4. Facilities getting deferred in national level assessment cannot apply for virtual assessments, such facilities will be assessed in physical mode.

You are requested to instruct the State Quality Assurance Units (SQAUs) to follow the above-mentioned protocols.
